SSH Surface Supplied Harness

Designed and manufactured by Aqua Lung. The Surface Supplied Harness (SSH) provides the commercial and military diver with a working harness for any tended surface or saturation diving application. The SSH is rugged, versatile and simple to don and adjust.



SSH Features:

Designed for durability, comfort and strength.

- Breaking strength of complete harness = 1100 lb / 500 kg / 4900 N
- Breaking strength of all 2" D-rings = 5000 lbs

Note: Surpasses strength requirements contained in ADCI Consensus Standards 2004

2 Sizes, fully adjustable:

- **Size 1 fits waists 30" to 38"**
- **Size 2 fits waists 38" to 46"**
- Adjustable vertical webbing
- Adjustable waist

Unique and highly reliable weight release system:

- Carries up to 20 lb on each side using SureLock® weight pockets
- Double Action Weight Release Sheath attaches to waistband using a military MOLLE weave design and Malice Clips®
- Weight Sheaths are reversible: vertical or inverted as required
- Up to 10 lb non-ditchable weights may be carried in a pouch inside the back of the SSH

Securely carries single bailout cylinder (cylinder not included)

Extraction points

- Easily accessible single point extraction D-Ring located at rear base of neck
- Two point extraction D-Rings located on each shoulder

The SSH may also be worn in conjunction with/over top of the Aqua Lung individual recovery harness called the Personal Diver Harness (PDH)*. When worn together, the SSH and PDH integrated harness combination, follows well-established industry best practice. This allows the outer SSH, which carries the dive equipment, to be removed in an emergency while retaining positive control of the diver by means of the PDH.
